



**Campfires** are permitted in ONLY in fire rings. Removal of any tree limb, branch, or other vegetation is prohibited, but dead and down wood may be used for campfires.

**Prepare food,** wash dishes and clean fish at campsites only, not in restrooms, at hydrants, or in bathrooms.

**Generators** may be used up to 4 hours a day between the hours of 8 am to 8 pm. Generators may NOT be used at night.

**Quiet hours** will be observed from 10 pm to 7 am, be considerate of other campers.

**Pets** must be on a leash or kept in a cage at all times. Pets are not to be left unattended in the campground and are not permitted in the bathroom. Clean up after your pet.

**Weapons and fireworks** cannot be discharged in the campground. Possession of firearms must conform to NC state law.

**Refunds** may be made only in serious situations. No refunds are given for weather.

**Garbage** must be placed in dumpsters located throughout the campground.

**Lost and found** items are turned in to the staff. If unclaimed after a time they are donated to a charity or disposed of properly. See the Manager for complete details

**Davidson River** is open all year. Stay limits are 14 days within 30 days within the time period from April 1 – October 31. Stay limits are 30 days from November 1 – March 31. The stay limit is cumulative and includes the following campgrounds: Lake Powhatan, North Mills River, Sunburst, and Davidson River.

**Gatehouse** is open from 7 am to 11 pm. May 1 to October 31.

**Reservations** may be made by contacting National Recreation Reservation System at 1-877-444-6777 or on line at [www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov) Reservations must be made at least 4 days in advance.

**Federal Interagency Passes** (senior and access) may be used only by the person to whom they are issued, for single sites. Pass holder must occupy the site.

**Campers** must be at least 18 years to rent a site and are responsible for the activities at site. Camp sites must be occupied the first night.

**Check Out** time is 2 P. M... Renew by 10 A.M.

**Speed Limit**— Observe the 15 M.P.H. and all traffic signs. All vehicles must conform to North Carolina law.

**Vehicles, RV's and Tents** must be on the pavement or gravel surface. Camping equipment should be kept on camp site. Vehicles must have all wheels on the pavement or gravel. Parking is not permitted on the grass, along the road or in vacant sites.

**Single Camp Sites** allow up to 8 people and 2 vehicles.

**Double Camp Sites** allow up to 16 people and 4 vehicles.

**Additional Cars** will be charged additional fee, and must be parked in an overflow parking area.
