To help ensure an enjoyable visit, please be aware of the following:

1. Register and pay for your site within 30 minutes after arrival. If you plan to stay additional nights, pay by 2:00 pm each day following. Check out time is 2:00 pm.
2. Reservations may be made by calling the National Forest Recreation Reservation System toll free at 1-877-444-6777. All other campsites are on FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS.
3. Site **MUST** be occupied first night and not left vacant for more than 24 hours thereafter. Camping equipment must occupy site at time of payment.
4. Golden Age/Access Passports may be used only by the person they are issued to. Passport holder may pay for only one site and must occupy that site under their passport. Other sites will be at the regular price.
5. Motorbikes, motorcycles or other motor vehicles are to be used on designated road ways and camping spurs within the campground.
6. Trailer and vehicles must have all wheels on the spur. Trailers may be parked on some tent pads. Two vehicles per site, space permitting. Parking is not permitted on unoccupied sites, along roads, nor on the grass.
7. Bicycles may not be ridden after dark.
8. Each campsite is limited to only one family, or group of 6 persons, and must include at least one person 18 years of age or older.
9. No more than 2 tents (or 1 R.V. and 1 tent) may be on the ground at any one site.
10. Pets must be on a leash or in a cage. Please do not bring pets into restrooms. Please clean up after your pet.
11. Campfires are permitted in grills as provided. Dead wood from ground may be used for firewood. Do not cut vegetation or standing trees.
12. Prepare food, wash dishes and clean fish at campsites only, not in rest room or at the hydrants.
13. Please maintain quiet hours from 10 pm to 7 am. Generators may run a maximum of four hours and only between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm and only for the purpose of charging batteries.
14. Do not leave hoses hooked up to water hydrants. Do not run electric cords to rest rooms unless authorized by management.
15. Discharge of firearms, including air rifles, and fireworks are prohibited within the campground.
16. You may change campsites only once during your stay.
